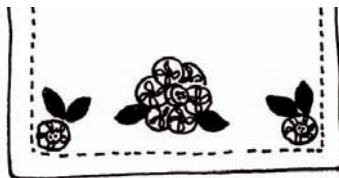


Recipe

Guest Towel with Yo-Yo Flowers

For each guest towel you will need:

- One *Wimpole Street* 15"x 20" hemstitched guest towel
- Nine *Wimpole Street* small yo-yos
- Six *Wimpole Street* crochet leaves
- Two *Wimpole Street* art deco flower buttons
- One *Wimpole Street* 3/4" round button
- 1/2 yard of coordinating embroidery floss
- Chenille needle
- Washable fabric glue



Sew the buttons into the centers of three yo-yos. Lightly mark the center of the short hemstitched edge of the guest towel. Place the yo-yo with the round button at the center mark, approximately 2" above the hem and glue in place. Glue six yo-yos around the outside to form a flower (see diagram). Glue the two yo-yos with flower buttons into the corners. Position and glue the leaves in place as shown. Allow the glue to dry thoroughly before using the guest towel.



Note: Yo-Yos are hand-made and sizes of finished projects will vary.
