

Recipe

Yo-Yo Snowman Ornament

For each snowman you will need:

- Two *Wimpole Street* 4" round cutwork doilies
- Four *Wimpole Street* Christmas yo-yos
- Three yards of cranberry embroidery floss
- Three yards of black embroidery floss
- 3"x 8" piece of black felt
- Two black 1/2" buttons
- 4" of floral wire
- 1/2"x 9" torn strip of ginger colored fabric
- 4"x 6" piece of bonded batting
- Chenille needle
- Low temp or craft glue

Cut two hat pieces from the felt, using the pattern provided. Cut a circle from the batting slightly smaller than the doilies, and a 1"x 2" strip for the nose.

Pin the circle of batting between the two doilies. Blanket-stitch around the outside edge of the doilies, using six strands of black floss.

Place the stitched doilies between the hat pieces and pin together as shown. Blanket-stitch around the outside edge of the hat, using six strands of cranberry floss. The portion of the hat that fits over the doily will be stitched to the doily.

NOSE - Fold the floral wire in half. Apply a small amount of glue to the folded end of the wire and place it on the corner of the batting strip (see above). Roll the batting around the wire into a cone as shown below. Glue the end of the strip to secure, tucking the batting into the fabric as necessary. Glue the nose to the snowman.

Sew or glue the buttons to the face for eyes. Overlap and glue the yo-yos on the hat for a band. Thread a 6" piece of floss through the top of the hat for a hanger.

VARIATION - Applique the snowmen to Christmas stockings and a tree skirt.



Note: Yo-Yos are hand-made and sizes of finished projects will vary.
